## Setting up for Success

### *Get in the Endodontic mode*

- A. Schedule your endo cases for either first or last of the day.
- B. Set-up armamentarium for efficiency.
- Take an active part in this step and train your assistant on this set-up.
  - Write it down in your endodontic training manual, so that future assistants can refer to this – this eliminates reinventing the wheel every time you have a new assistant.
  - Take photos of your ideal endo room set-up.
  - Pre-set your endo trays on a tray rack. Mount the rubber dam sheet on the frame and punch the hole in the center, load the anesthetic syringe, etc.

- Use minimal file systems.
  - Have your supply of brand-new files for at least 10 cases set-up on a sponge block for easy access.
- C. Invest in training your endo assistant. Remember to document your clinical training manual as you go.
